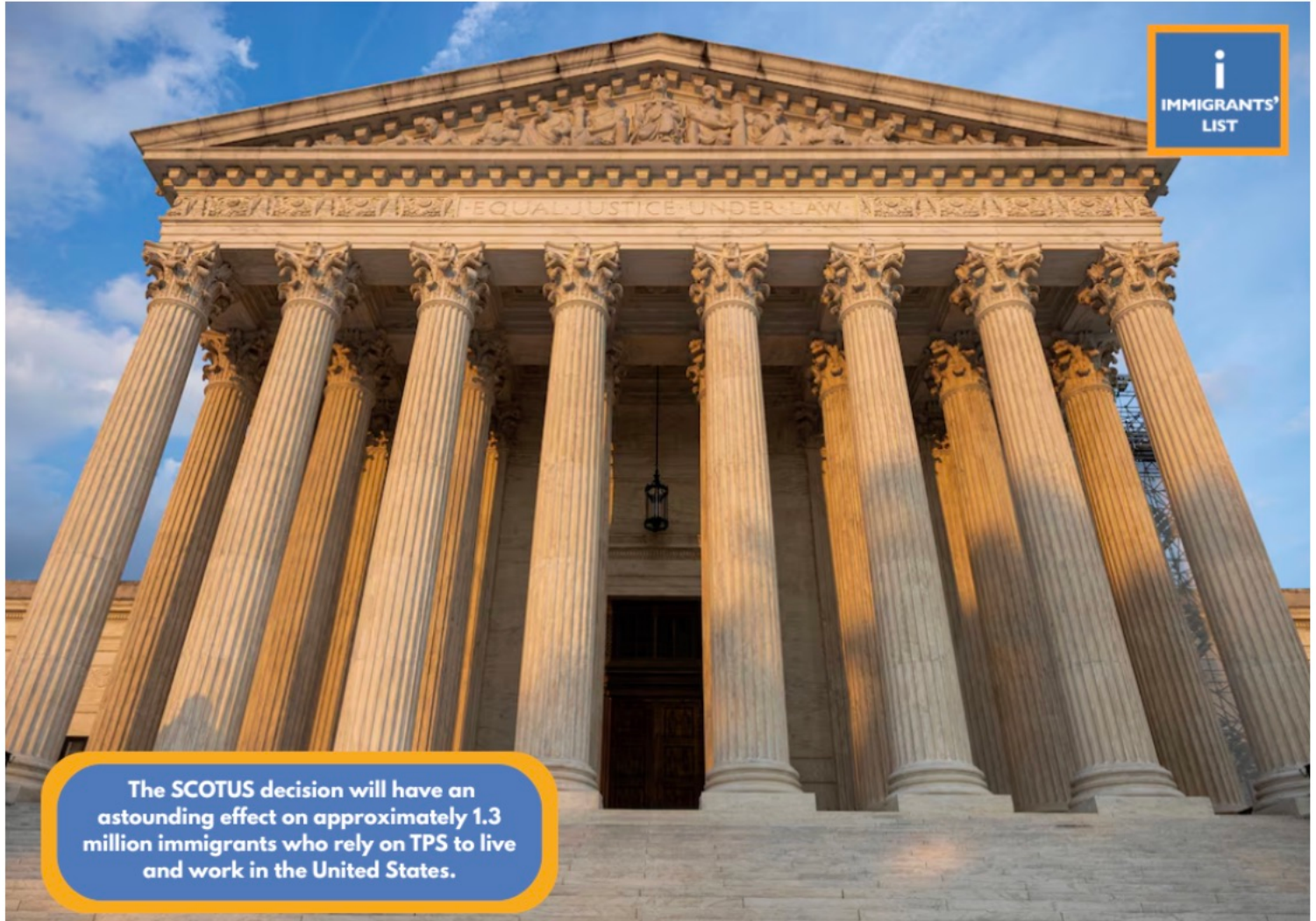




The Supreme Court gave Trump the green light to terminate the legal status of over one million people who were granted permission to live in the United States after fleeing crises in their homelands. [The 6-3 decision allows the White House to strip hundreds of thousands of Haitians and Syrians who sought refuge in the United States after fleeing war, violence, and destruction in their home countries.](#) The SCOTUS decision will have an astounding effect on approximately 1.3 million immigrants who rely on TPS to live and work in the United States.

Haitians and Syrians are not murderers; they are not criminals; they are not the ‘worst of the worst’ as this administration claims. They are hardworking, family-loving people who came to the United States to build a better life for themselves and their families. They are people who have no safe place to go. The Trump administration **falsely declared that Haiti and Syria are safe to return to, but that is obviously not the case. Syria remains**

unstable and fractured, with widespread poverty, economic collapse, and ongoing security concerns. Likewise, Haiti continues to face severe violence and a humanitarian crisis.



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This ruling paves the way for the Trump Administration to continue their cruel mass deportation agenda. **We cannot let this happen.** TPS was created as a temporary humanitarian protection for people from countries experiencing conditions such as armed conflict, natural disasters, or other extraordinary circumstances that make safe return difficult. While the Trump administration emphasizes that Temporary Protected Status (TPS) is intended to be temporary, **ending these protections is not justifiable when conditions in the affected countries remain unstable and unsafe.** Deporting thousands of people back to countries facing ongoing crises would simply **undermine the humanitarian purpose of TPS.**
